Indoor Environment Quality	EQI 12 Low-Emitting Materials	This credit includes requirements for product manufacturing as well as project teams. It covers volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions in the indoor air and the VOC content of materials, as well as the testing methods by which indoor VOC emissions are determined. Different materials must meet different requirements to be considered compliant for this credit.	1-3	Our products can be left unfinished or utilize low-VOC finishes. We aim to use healthy finishes that comply with LEED requirements.
Regional Priority	RPc 1 Regional Priority	Six Regional Priority credits have been identified by the USGBC regional councils and chapters as having special importance for a project's region. If an RP Credit is earned, then a bonus point is awarded to the project's total points.	1-4	Our qualifying credits are regional priorities in many major cities including Minneapolis, San Francisco, and Portland.
